Dear President:

The ORGANIZATION OF VENEZUELANS IN EXILE – ORVEX, in occasion of the death of Osama bin Laden, expresses the following to the world public opinion and to the governments of the countries of the free world, including the government that you preside, in which territories there are Venezuelans in exile who are in danger of being deported to Venezuela:

1. - Our most sincere and warmth congratulations to the U.S. Armed Forces for the impeccable operation of surgical precision carried out by the elite soldiers of the Navy Seals in which the number 1 enemy of the World, Osama bin Laden, was killed.

2. - Our great worry for the safety of Venezuelans in exile who are in the free world and in danger of being deported to Venezuela, to kindly and urgently request that the governments of such countries grant them a special humanitarian protection which differs their deportation due to the danger they might experience higher reprisals by the government of Hugo Chavez. This is so because our organization ORVEX has carried out public denounces regarding the presence of the Al-Qaida terrorist network in Venezuela and against the support that Hugo Chavez provides, as part of Venezuelan state policy, to international terrorism, which are known worldwide as it is shown on page 72 of the Spanish version of the book "THE PALESTINIAN" of renown Spaniard journalist Antonio Salas, and as it is seen in some of our videos uploaded to YouTube, which have been seen almost 18 million times with an average of 12,000 views per day.
